ANIMALS AND PLANTS (PROTECTION OF ENDANGERED SPECIES) ORDINANCE (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 3) NOTICE 2000

(Made under section 19(1A) of the Animals and Plants (Protection of Endangered Species) Ordinance (Cap. 187))

## 1. Commencement

This Notice shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Secretary for the Environment and Food by notice in the Gazette.

## 2. Scheduled Plants

Schedule 3 to the Animals and Plants (Protection of Endangered Species) Ordinance (Cap. 187) is amended---

- (a) in Part 1, by repealing the note and substituting---
- "Note In this Part, the specification of a plant in column 2---
- (a) does not include the specification of its seed, spore, pollen (including pollinia), seedling or tissue culture obtained in vitro;
- (b) includes the specification of an artificially propagated plant, its parts and derivatives other than its seed, spore, pollen (including pollinia), seedling or tissue culture obtained in vitro and cut flowers.";
- (b) in Part 2, by repealing the note and substituting---
- "Note In this Part, the specification of a plant in column 2---
- (a) does not include the specification of its seed, spore, pollen (including pollinia), seedling or tissue culture obtained in vitro;
- (b) includes the specification of an artificially propagated plant, its parts and derivatives other than its seed, spore, pollen (including pollinia), seedling or tissue culture obtained in vitro and cut flowers.".

This Notice amends Schedule 3 to the Animals and Plants (Protection of Endangered Species) Ordinance (Cap. 187) ("the Ordinance") to include in the controls in the Ordinance artificially propagated plant species for the purposes of giving effect to the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora.
